	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	What are some general locations proposers can observe facilities that are pictured in the RFP	<p>Along NE 119th Street there are sections with a range of condition – one is between 96th Ave and 111th Ave, and another from NE 54th Ct to NE 65th Ave.</p> <p>Another example would be along NE 71st Street west of NE 94th Ave.</p>
2.	Are we expected to visit and categorize all of the failing facilities as part of this manual, or is this simply to provide criteria that your inspector or the maintenance contractor can use to identify and prioritize repairs, rehabilitation, or retrofit?	<p>There is no requirement to visit and categorize all individual failing facilities as part of manual development. We expect field visits will be desirable to help characterize general categories and approaches. County staff will later categorize individual facilities to prioritize repairs, rehab, or retrofit by the future maintenance contractor.</p>
