The Clark County Solid Waste Advisory Commission has extensively reviewed and actively participated in the revision and update of Clark County's Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan (which, through this revision, now incorporates the Moderate Risk Waste Plan).

This plan update has been an extensive process. There have been many opportunities for citizens, businesses, local governments and the solid waste industry to participate and comment, including more than three dozen public SWAC meetings and fourteen city and community presentations over the course of the update period. This Plan is now ready for adoption by the councils of the cities & town and by the Board of County Commissioners.
