All Members	Meeting called to order at 1:30 PM
All Members	Significant amount of discussion about new laws enacted in Oregon regarding requirements for van accessible parking
Dave Maret	Dave Maret explained that there may be possible review of the building code in Washington regarding identifying accessible stalls as "No Parking Areas".
Trenton Hanson Tim McVicker	Bud Van Cleve indicated that a county name badge was needed for Trenton. Trenton is a new committee member. Tim McVicker will contact the PIO office regarding name badge acquisition.
All Members Tim McVicker	Committee members were concerned about the need to inform and educate the community regarding the necessity to improve accessible parking at businesses and public accommodations throughout Clark County. It was proposed that the Columbian Newspaper be invited to a committee meeting to discuss the possibility of preparing a story on this topic. Tim McVicker will attempt to obtain permission through General Services and the Public Information Office to explore this further.
All Members	The accessibility survey for the Art Curtis Children's Justice Center was approved and will be posted on the ADA web site.
Tim McVicker	Dave Maret and Tim McVicker reviewed the architectural plan for the Clark County Family court to be located north of and adjacent to the Juvenile Justice Center. Improvements needed within the Juvenile Justice Center will also be used by Family Court. Tim McVicker will contact General Services to discuss incorporation of these improvements in the Family Court remodel plan. ( <u>Note</u> : A meeting has been scheduled for March 29, 2008)
Dave Maret	Dave Maret conducted an additional review of the Camas Court for accessibility. Several additional items were noted. Dave's report will be posted on the ADA web page.
All Members	The next ADA Accessibility Survey will be the Sheriff's Office Central
