Dave Maret	Dave Maret and Tim McVicker conducted a review of the plans for the renovation of the English Pit shooting range. It was noted that the range was not accessible to individuals with disabilities. A pathway meeting slope requirements as well as providing accessible shooting platforms was needed at at least two of the four shooting platforms. Following Dave's and Tim's review no additional comments have been heard. Dave will attempt to ascertain what, if anything, is being done regarding continued development of the shooting range.
