All Members	<p>Meeting called to order at 1:30 PM Guest attending the meeting: Ms. Katie Hatteras</p>
Tim McVicker	<p>Agenda:</p> <p>Tim McVicker showed the Committee the newly implemented employee's intranet ADA web page. The internal web page is to assist county employees in addressing and researching information as needed to better serve citizens with disabilities who seek services from the county. As part of this review, the Committee watched the CVTV video productions on the accessible voting booths and Public Access Videos phones or PAVs. All of the videos have been closed captioned. Katie Hatteras, a citizen attending the Committee meeting, asked how much the video phones cost (7,000 each) and how many other county buildings should have this type of phone. Tim McVicker stated that it would be good to have additional phones in the Juvenile Justice Center, the Public Service Center, the Family Court Annex and the Elections Building. Katie Hatteras said that she would research if there were any funding sources for this purpose.</p> <p>Tim McVicker also explored utilizing the <i>i</i>-711 relay service in county buildings as a means to permit deaf and hard-of-hearing individuals to access county computers for communication purposes. Tim wanted to acquire a single <i>i</i>-711 username and password for all county computers. However, the relay service said that each computer would need to be registered individually. Because of this the county will not to use the service as hoped.</p> <p>Tim McVicker was informed that due to the current economic crisis, Clark County is unable to allocate funds for the ADA fund for the 2009/2010 biennial budget. As required by Title II of the ADA, Tim McVicker has prepared a statement for the County's deputy administrator to sign documenting the reasons for this decision. The letter, when signed and approved, will be posted on the County's web page in the Transition Plan.</p> <p>The Citizen's ADA Advisory Committee completed the accessibility survey review of the new Youth House.
