Tim McVicker	<p>Survey Review – North County Family Resource Center Concerns: It is proposed in the survey that the access aisle located adjacent to the only van accessible parking stall be reversed with the parking stall to preclude individuals going into the vehicular way when accessing the building. Wayne noted that a van with a side-load wheelchair ramp would need to back into the stall which could be problematic for some people. It was suggested that the parking stall be equipped with two access aisles; one on each side of the parking stall. Tim McVicker will forward the recommendation to Laura Pedersen the project manager for the renovation of that building.</p> <p>Wayne also suggested that instead of a power door being installed at the south entrance of this building that consideration be given to installing an automatic door similar to the type used in grocery stores that open for everyone. Again, this information will be forwarded to Laura Pedersen.</p>
