Tim McVicker	<p>Parking Lot Seminar</p> <p>Wayne Yarnall would like the Committee and his non-profit organization to sponsor a seminar for contractors and paving companies regarding proper layout and construction of parking lots as it pertains to accessible parking. Tim McVicker will look into any legal issues regarding this sponsorship.</p>
Teresa Guise	<p>Youth House Accessibility Survey</p> <p>The committee reviewed the report regarding accessibility issues at the Youth House located at 1112 Columbia Street. This is a privately owned building wherein the county leases office space for a Community Service office.</p> <p>Teresa Guise noted that she had been in contact with the City of Vancouver regarding this building. There may have been some review oversights when the accessibility ramp was constructed. Also, Teresa advised that only of the restrooms needs to be made accessible. Further, Teresa would like to revisit the house to ascertain if handrails are in fact required on both side of the interior stairwell.</p>
Tim McVicker	<p>Tim McVicker will make the necessary corrections to the survey following Teresa's review. A copy of the report will then be forwarded to the City of Vancouver and the Children's Home Society of Washington, owner of the house. The City of Vancouver will ask Children's Home Society to make the necessary improvements and the Clark County Department of Community Development is willing to offer assistance in guiding</p>
