Members	Meeting Commenced – 1:00 PM
	<p>Tim McVicker distributed the draft Clark County Transition Plan. Tim advised that he had met earlier in the day with the director for General Services, the Risk Management officer and the manager of the Facilities Management Department to review the accessibility surveys done to date for prioritization of upgrades.</p> <p>Clark County has budgeted \$200,000 for ADA improvements during this budget cycle. In addition, approximately 30,000.00 additional dollars was allocated for sidewalk repair and ramp construction into the Franklin Building.</p> <p>The committee reviewed fund allocation for the accessibility projects and approved the allocations.</p>
Tim McVicker	<p>Wayne Yarnall suggested that as part of the architectural review of the Public Service Center barrier construction and crosswalk identification, that the existing disabled parking stalls be re-examined for better utilization of existing space.</p> <p>The parking stalls in questions are angle parking and the access aisles greatly exceed width specifications. Due to the size of the access aisles and the angle parking it is possible that one or two additional disabled stalls could be created. Tim McVicker will discuss this with Darrel Stump, Facilities Management manager.</p>
	<p>Tim McVicker advised that as a member of the Vancouver-Clark Parks ADA Accessibility Committee, the City/County Parks department will re-evaluate parks for accessibility when funds are available for improvements. The current accessibility surveys are identified only as an initial starting point.</p>
	<p>Lewisville Island Ramp Bridges. – Tim McVicker informed the committee that the island ramp bridge rails would be extended for safety and accessibility concerns. Cost is estimated to be 15,000.00 and work on the project is</p>
