All Members	<p data-bbox="435 709 993 745">Meeting called to order at 1:30 PM</p> <p data-bbox="435 789 1073 825">Accessibility Improvement Projects</p> <p data-bbox="435 867 1433 940">Tim McVicker outlined accessibility improvement projects that are currently under way:</p> <ol data-bbox="435 961 1466 1858" style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="435 961 1466 1186">1. Blueprints have been drawn up to make the ramp between the Law Enforcement Center and the Courthouse accessible. The committee reviewed this plan. An initial estimate for reconstruction of the ramp, which was originally built in 1984, is \$80,000. However, a final estimate has not been received.<li data-bbox="435 1207 1333 1281">2. Restroom accessibility signs have been placed in the Courthouse and Dolle Building.<li data-bbox="435 1302 1369 1375">3. Restroom accessibility signs have been ordered for the Juvenile Justice Center.<li data-bbox="435 1396 1437 1470">4. Exterior accessible entrance signs have been placed on the Dolle building.<li data-bbox="435 1491 1398 1564">5. Lever action door knobs have been ordered for the Dolle Building.<li data-bbox="435 1585 1466 1690">6. Barriers are being constructed to prevent individuals with vision disabilities from walking under staircases in the Public Service Center parking garage.<li data-bbox="435 1711 1437 1858">7. Truncated domes have been ordered for placement around the downtown county campus. Domes will not be placed between the Courthouse and the Public Service Center on 13th Street until architectural plans are drafted regarding

	<p>improvements for pedestrian crossings.</p> <p>8. The stairs on the SW corner of the Public Service Center are being removed and a ramp constructed in its place. Plans have been drafted and are under review by the City of Vancouver. Construction of the ramp should begin soon. Cost for this project is approximately \$10,000</p> <p>9. Clark County reviewed accessibility issues connected with the Camas District Courthouse building. The county is exploring its options regarding this building.</p>
	<p>Committee Member Retirement</p> <p>Connie Brittian announced her separation from the Citizens ADA Advisory Committee. Connie is attending college classes and working at NW Disability Resources. She said that time limitations forced her to make this decision. Connie has been a great member of the team and will be missed. We wish her the best of luck in all her pursuits.</p>
	<p>Vacant Committee Positions</p> <p>Two Committee positions are scheduled to expire in December 2007; Connie Brittian and Jesse Magana. Jesse has expressed a desire to remain on the Committee. Tim McVicker has asked the Board of County Commissioners to announce one new committee opening and to have Jesse's position extended another two years. Teresa Guise also is no longer serving on the committee. However, the committee decided not to back fill her position but simply have an individual in the County Building Department serve as a contact for technical questions. David Maret has been serving in that capacity for several months.</p>
