	Meeting called to order at 1:30 PM
All Members Jesse Magana	<p>Tim McVicker listed all the accessibility projects that are currently being conducted by Clark County.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Public Service Center walkway – A ramp is being constructed on the west end of the south covered walkway. - Architectural plans have been completed for the area between the Courthouse and the Law Enforcement center. The ADA Committee was asked to participate in the plan review on October 2, 2007. - Risk management Office is ordering a wheelchair for the Public Service Center. Jesse Magana stated that he may be able to located chairs at reduced costs and will report back to the committee on this. - Area of refuge signs will be installed on the south-central stairs at the Clark County Center for Community Health - Signage for Dolle Building (accessible entrances and restrooms) has been ordered - Lever action door handles are being ordered for the Dolle Building - The ATM machine will be moved from its current location on the east side of the Courthouse to an accessible location on the ground floor. - Sidewalk improvements will be started on the south side of the Courthouse - Truncated domes are being order for the downtown county campus. - Architectural plans are being drafted for the south side of the Public Service Center in order to create definite pedestrian crossways. - Cross railings for Lewisville Park bridges are being ordered.
Tim McVicker	<p>Dolle Building</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tim McVicker needs to check with the Vancouver City Fire Marshal Office about making the east ground floor exit an area of refuge.
Tim McVicker	<p>Public Service Center – Scooter parking</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wayne Yarnall suggested that an ADA parking stall be identified for motorcycles as there is one ADA stall on the south side of the Public Service Center that is constantly occupied by a scooter. Wayne felt this was a poor use of space. Tim McVicker will pass this suggestion on to the Clark County Facilities Management Office for consideration.
Wayne Yarnall	<p>County Auditor Office – Elections Office ADA Committee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Clark County Elections Office is forming a Citizens ADA

	Accessibility Advisory Committee. Wayne Yarnall suggested that the current Citizen's ADA Advisory Committee provide this service to the Elections Department. Wayne stated he will contact the Clark County Auditor, Greg Kimsey, regarding this.
Tim McVicker	Clark County ADA Training <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesse Magana would like to show the NW Disabilities Resource Center staff the ADA training series that Clark County provides to employees. Tim McVicker will make a copy of the presentation for Jesse.
