5. Return the completed and signed form to the Clark County Elections Department at the address shown above.

Your status as a permanent absentee (mail ballot) voter will be terminated upon:

1. Your written request;
2. Cancellation of your registration record;
3. Death or disqualification; or
4. Return of an ongoing absentee ballot as undeliverable.

You will receive a mail ballot for each election in which you are entitled to vote. To ensure delivery of your ballot, we must have your current address. *Mail ballots are not forwardable, without a current address you will not receive a ballot.*
