### **Commissioners to consider formal action on growth plan**

Vancouver, WA – The Board of Clark County Commissioners will consider formal action on a proposed ordinance to change the county's Comprehensive Growth Management Plan at 10 a.m. September 25 on the sixth floor of the Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin St., Vancouver.

If approved, the ordinance will change urban growth boundaries, zoning in newly designated urban areas, written planning policies and development regulations included in Title 40 of the Clark County Code.

An extensive series of public meetings and hearings to examine the growth plan began in 2005 and continued through July 5, 2007, when the Board closed public testimony.

The "BOCC Tentative Land Use Map – August 14, 2007" and written policies contained in the "20-Year Comprehensive Growth Management Plan – August 2007" are the key elements of the proposed plan changes.
