Three Creeks council to discuss proposed bicycle and pedestrian plan

Vancouver, WA – Clark County's Three Creeks Advisory Council will meet on Thursday, Oct. 14 from 10 a.m. to noon. The meeting will be open to the public, at the offices of the Clark Regional Wastewater District, 8000 NE 52nd Court, in the Hazel Dell area.

The council will focus on bicycle and pedestrian issues throughout the planning area. In addition, the agenda will include an overview of the county's commercial code streamlining efforts, review the proposal to lift urban holding along Interstate 5 north of NE 199th Street and an update on the Salmon Creek Sub-area Plan Taskforce recommendations.

The Board of Clark County Commissioners appointed the council to assist the county on transportation, land-use planning and related issues in the planning area, which includes unincorporated areas around Hazel Dell, Felida, Lake Shore, Salmon Creek and the fairgrounds.
