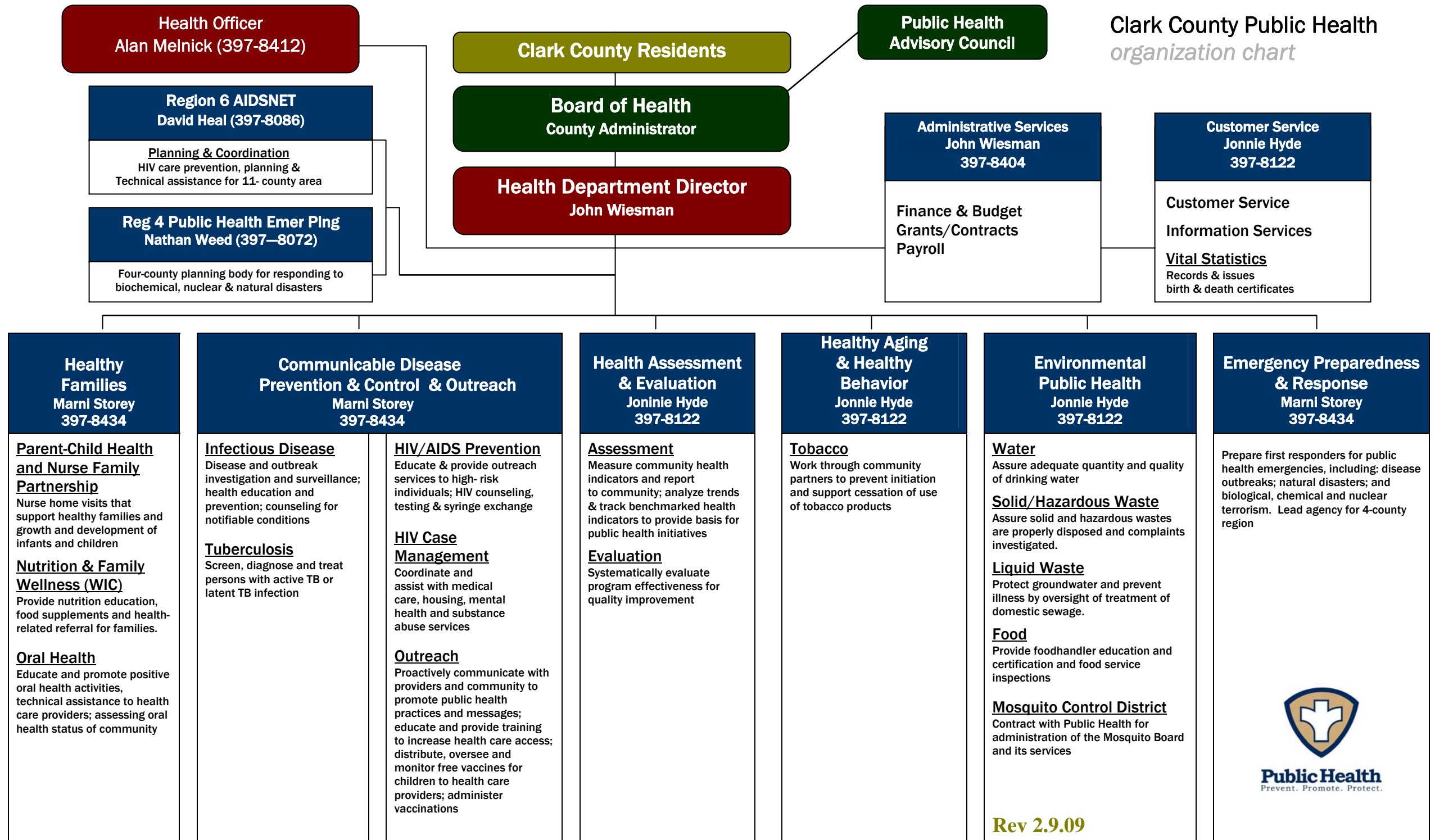

Parent-Child Health and Nurse Family Partnership

Nurse home visits that support healthy families and growth and development of infants and children

Nutrition & Family Wellness (WIC)

Provide nutrition education, food supplements and health-related referral for families.

Oral Health

Educate and promote positive oral health activities, technical assistance to health care providers; assessing oral health status of community

Infectious Disease

Disease and outbreak investigation and surveillance; health education and prevention; counseling for notifiable conditions

Tuberculosis

Screen, diagnose and treat persons with active TB or latent TB infection

HIV/AIDS Prevention

Educate & provide outreach services to high- risk individuals; HIV counseling, testing & syringe exchange

HIV Case Management

Coordinate and assist with medical care, housing, mental health and substance abuse services

Outreach

Proactively communicate with providers and community to promote public health practices and messages; educate and provide training to increase health care access; distribute, oversee and monitor free vaccines for children to health care providers; administer vaccinations

Assessment

Measure community health indicators and report to community; analyze trends & track benchmarked health indicators to provide basis for public health initiatives

Evaluation

Systematically evaluate program effectiveness for quality improvement

Work through community partners to prevent initiation and support cessation of use of tobacco products

Water

Assure adequate quantity and quality of drinking water

Solid/Hazardous Waste

Assure solid and hazardous wastes are properly disposed and complaints investigated.

Liquid Waste

Protect groundwater and prevent illness by oversight of treatment of domestic sewage.

Food

Provide foodhandler education and certification and food service inspections
