Dear Clark County resident:

Starting in July, Clark County Public Works will begin its annual chip seal road surface treatment program work. This chip seal treatment is applied to roads to preserve and protect the surface and prevent moisture from damaging the road. Each road project will take one to three days to complete. Our chip seal program is scheduled between mid-July and late August, weather permitting.

Road crews will post loose gravel and fresh oil signs in your neighborhood prior to treatment. Drivers should reduce speed through these work zones. We will not close any roads but there may be some temporary delays. The program work will begin in the northwest area and move clockwise throughout Clark County finishing in the Hazel Dell area. We appreciate your patience during this work.
