Dear Resident:

Your neighborhood street is scheduled for surface improvements this year, weather and budget permitting. We are working to provide the most cost effective surface treatment available for your road. We hope you appreciate the benefits of these improvements. We will do everything we can to minimize the inconvenience this might cause you and your neighbors.

To help you understand what to expect, we have enclosed a brochure explaining the entire procedure. Street preparation (Phase 1 & 2) will begin soon in many areas as weather conditions allow. Although the roads will not be closed at this time, there may be some inconvenience to area residents and drivers.

Clark County Public Works together with Intermountain Slurry Seal Association will be completing the final phase (Phase 3) of the road improvements scheduled for your area during June, July and August. This work will require the street to be closed. You will receive a final notice of this closure 24 to 48 hours in advance of this work. That notice, in the form of a door hanger, will inform you that there will be no parking or driving allowed on your street that day. Your cooperation with this will be greatly appreciated.

Some of you may have received this notice last year, but we were unable to complete the work. These areas will have early priority for resurfacing this year.
