HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTIONS: Household products such as pesticides, paints, solvents, batteries, thinners, motor oil, antifreeze, and cleaners may be hazardous. Look for the signal words *poison*, *danger*, *warning*, *caution*, or *flammable* on the label.

- ✓ **What Will Be Accepted?** Most household hazardous wastes will be accepted; all wastes must be from households.
- ✓ **What Will Not Be Accepted?** Explosives, radioactive materials, ammunition, biological material or business generated wastes.
- ✓ **How Do I Prepare My Household Hazardous Waste?** Keep products in their original containers whenever possible, don't mix products together; keep products in sealed containers to prevent leaks and spills; transport products away from the driver and passengers.
- ✓ **What If I Can't Make It To A Collection Event?** You can take your household hazardous waste to following collection facilities:

Disposal of household hazardous wastes at facilities or events is free of charge; however, there is a 25-gallon or 220-pound limit at the facilities.

ELECTRONICS COLLECTION EVENTS:*

- Items **ACCEPTED**: computers, monitors, TV's, and laptops **ONLY**.

BLOCK FOAM COLLECTION EVENTS:*

- Items **ACCEPTED**: block foam (Styrofoam®) clean, any color and bagged/boxed. Peanuts that snap when bent if double-bagged
- Items **NOT ACCEPTED**: foam hot tub covers and plastic-wrapped, yellow urethane foam.
