August primary and special election logic and accuracy test scheduled for June 6, 2017

Vancouver, WA – At 10 a.m. Tuesday, June 6, the Clark County Elections Office will conduct a logic and accuracy test of the programming to be used to tabulate ballots and the accessible voting units for the August 1, primary and special election.

The test will be held at the Clark County Elections Office, 1408 Franklin St., Vancouver. Members of the news media, candidates, jurisdictions with measures on the ballot and the public are invited to attend this test, which is required under Washington law.

Ballots will be mailed Friday, July 14.

For this election, only voters in the city of Camas, city of La Center, city of Vancouver, city of Washougal, city of Woodland, town of Yacolt, Evergreen School District, Hockinson School District, Vancouver School District, Clark Regional Wastewater District, Clark County Fire and Rescue, and Clark County Emergency Medical Service District No. 1 will receive ballots.

At 6 p.m. Election Day, Tuesday, August 1, the process of entering the scanned ballot information into the ballot tabulation system will begin.

Election results will be available at or before 8:30 p.m. on the Auditor's website at clarkvotes.org.
