August 1, 2017 Primary and Special Election Voter Registration Deadlines

Vancouver, WA – The last day to submit a mail-in voter registration form to be eligible to vote in the August 1 Primary and Special Election is Monday, July 3.

Online registration applications can be submitted up to 11:59 p.m. Monday, July 3. Visit the Elections Office website at clarkvotes.org and click on *MyVote* to register online.

Current registered voters who wish to change their address online must do so before midnight on Monday, July 3, for the August 1 Primary and Special Election. The Clark County Elections Office will be open until 5 p.m. Monday, July 3, to accept address changes made by telephone or in person.

Citizens who are not currently registered to vote in the state of Washington have additional time and may register to vote by appearing in person at the **Clark County Elections Office**, **1408 Franklin Street**, **Vancouver** through Monday, July 24.

Only voters in city of Camas Ward 1, city of La Center, city of Vancouver, city of Washougal, city of Woodland, town of Yacolt, Evergreen School District, Hockinson School District, Vancouver School District, Clark Regional Wastewater District, Clark County Fire & Rescue and Clark County Emergency Medical Service District No. 1 will receive ballots for this election.
