RE: E-Verify Annual Report for 2012 - 2015

On November 10, 2010 the E-Verify policy was changed, by direction of the BOCC, to include all vendors participating in Clark County's formal competitive processes (excluding competitive bids for commercially available products).

Purchasing continues to track and verify participating vendors' E-Verify Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) and update the Board of County Commissioners.

The following report identifies the total compliant and non-compliant vendors with the Clark County E-Verify policy:

- In 2012 - 2015, total participation increased from 287 to 658 vendors.
- All non-compliant vendors have been notified by mail of the requirement to submit their E-Verify MOU before they are eligible to participate in any Clark County competitive process.
- The following 34 vendors are non-compliant:
