



Downloading PDFCreator

Start by going to pdfforge.org




Select PDFCreator


Select Download on the next window




Select Download on the PDFCreator window not PDFCreator Plus (you have to pay for plus)




You do not need to select anything on the next page unless the download will not start. Do not select any of the blue buttons. Those are ads.



If you get a popup window asking to Run or Save select the Run option




Select English for your language from the next window and click OK



Make sure to check the 'Expert Settings' box and then select Next





In the next window, you need to browse to where you want to install PDFCreator.




****Very Important****

In the Select Components window PDF Architect is already selected. You need to click in the box to make it unselected. If the Architect component downloads, it causes problems creating the TIF images.






Select Next after the Architect has been unselected. Select Next in the Select Start Menu Folder window.




You are now ready to install so select Install in the next window.



Once the installation is complete PDFCreator is going to offer PDF Architect again. Select No Thanks.




Uncheck show help after setup. To complete the installation select Finish.




PDFCreator has now been installed.


Now we are ready to set up PDFCreator. This should be a onetime setup. Start by selecting Profile Settings.




The Profile at the top should be set to Default Profile.




In the Save tab, change the default file format to TIF.




In the Auto Save tab select Enable automatic saving and then choose where you want you TIF files saved.



In the Image Formats tab change the colors under the TIFF Settings to Black and White (2 bit G4 Fax).




Still in the Image Formats tab and under the TIFF settings, change the Resolution to 300. Select Save when finished.



On the initial set up menu select Application Settings.



Select the Printers tab and make sure PDFCreator is selected as the Primary Printer and the Profile is set as Default Profile, if not double click in the profile section and select Default Profile from the drop down.



Select save when finished. You are now ready to create TIF images.
