The following are the agreed partnership terms between the Clark County DCS and the City of Vancouver, and special event approval for the NW Recovery Walk on Sunday September 14, 2014. This event celebrates recovery with a walk from Vancouver Landing to the Columbian boardwalk. This event begins at 8:00 a.m. and runs until approximately 12:00 p.m., and takes place at Vancouver Landing and a pre-arranged fun walk route through the city. Event sets up around 7:00 am with strike-down at 12:00 pm.

As it relates to the above-described event, THE CITY agrees to:

VANCOUVER POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Provide emergency service through 9-1-1.

VANCOUVER FIRE DEPARTMENT

- Provide emergency service through 9-1-1.
- May inspect tents, vendors, beer garden/fenced areas prior to the beginning of the event.

VANCOUVER-CLARK PARKS & RECREATION

- Special Use Permit approved for use of Esther Short Park.

- City staff will be on site to ensure park rules are followed, and for access to park utilities and monitoring during set-up, strike and at key times during the event. Assigned city staff will have access to the event free of any ticket charges or fees. **City staff are not adjunct staff to the event.**

The city of Vancouver is not responsible for any services not mentioned in this agreement.

As it relates to the above-described event, Clark County DCS agrees to:

- Be responsible for the well-being, health and safety of all event participants.
- Will obtain and provide copy of certificate of insurance to cover all activities (unless already on file), as outlined in the special events permit application and approved by City Risk Management staff.

IN CONSIDERATION OF BEING PERMITTED TO PRODUCE THIS SPECIAL EVENT OR ACTIVITY OR USE OF ANY CITY PROPERTY OR FACILITIES IN CONNECTION WITH THIS ACTIVITY, THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES TO:

- 1) RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the City, its employees, officers and elected officials from any and all liability, claims, demands, causes of action, charges, expenses, and attorney fees (including attorney fees to establish the City's right to indemnity or incurred on appeal) resulting from involvement in this event whether caused by any negligent act or omission of the City or otherwise. This agreement shall not apply to any liability resulting from the sole negligence of the City.
- 2) Reimburse the City for any loss, theft of, or damage to City property, equipment and/or facilities.
- 3) Comply with all applicable laws, statutes, ordinances, rules and requirements including, but not limited to, not admitting more attendees than designated by Fire Marshal's office as safe for the particular event or facility.

The INDEMNITOR expressly agrees that this release and hold harmless agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by Washington law and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, notwithstanding, the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.






