This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") relates to the procedures by which the "Monitoring Agency" identified below will monitor the compliance of contractors and subcontractors with certain federal labor standards on CDBG funds provided by the County pursuant to the Agreement with Community Services Northwest, #2014-CDBG-1409, dated _____, 2014.

"Monitoring Agency": City of Vancouver

The City of Vancouver agrees to assume all responsibility for monitoring and enforcement of Federal Labor standards compliance on the funded project in accordance with HUD Handbook 1344.1, Rev. 1, related HUD Labor Relations guidebooks (29 CFR Part 1, 3, 5, 6, 7) and Labor Relations Letters, the Contract Work Hours & Safety Standards Act, and the Copeland Act. This includes retention of records pertaining to Federal Davis-Bacon requirements. The City of Vancouver also agrees that it will be solely responsible for addressing any wage restitution for any violation of the Federal Labor Standards by itself or any Contractor or Sub-contractor hired by Community Services Northwest for this project. Records relating to the City of Vancouver's Federal Labor Standards compliance efforts will be made available to Clark County for review upon request. The City of Vancouver will send Clark County a copy of the final Labor Standards Report Form submitted to HUD for this Project.

To confirm our mutual understanding, we have signed the foregoing MOU on the dates set forth below.






