
This bid is to replace existing security boxes that have begun to fail. The use of electronic key check in and out systems began as a corrections industry best practice. However, in the past several years has moved to an industry standard.

Purchasing received a sole response to bid #2628. The bid was checked for accuracy, content and compliance to specifications.

Invitations to bid were sent to eight vendors of whom one response was received. The Jail administration reviewed the response and determined it to be in compliance to specifications and below the original estimate based on market research of potential vendors.

Purchasing and the Jail Administration feel there is sufficient information to insure competitive pricing and therefore recommend that Bid #2628 be awarded to the sole bidder, Morse Watchmans of Oxford, CT in the total bid amount of \$36,471.73 including Washington Sales Tax.
