SUBJECT: Award of Bid #2637 – Annual Emulsified Oil

The purpose of this bid is to establish an annual requirements contract to purchase three different types of emulsified oil for annual testing with the intent to select a primary group. Each group will be used during a calendar year in the chip seal road surface treatment process completed by Public Works Road Crews in the rural areas of Clark County to seal the surface from moisture infiltration.

Purchasing received two responses to Bid #2637. The bids were checked for accuracy, content, and compliance to specifications.

Purchasing and Public Works recommend that Annual Emulsified Oil be awarded annually by group with the total annual amount not to exceed any one group including Washington State Sales Tax as follows:

- 1. Albina Asphalt:
 - a. Group 1 - \$1,070,700.00
 - b. Group 3 - \$1,070,700.00
- 2. Blue Line Transportation Company Inc.:
 - a. Group 2 - \$1,158,400.00

Hi Beth and Mike,

It is my recommendation that Clark County awards (Group 1 and 3) to Albina Asphalt based on the total base bid amount in each group so we don't have to split up the CRS-2P and CSS-1H Dilute with two suppliers. I would award (Group 2) to Blue Line Transportation. If for any reason we have a problem in the future with product or service we can look to rebid the contract versus extending the current bid for another year up to four years.
