

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

Clark County will temporarily close NW 41st Avenue, about 100 feet south of NW 179th Street, beginning Monday, Aug. 3, 2015.

The closure is necessary so a contractor can stabilize the failing roadway slope on the east side of NW 41st Avenue, which is unstable because of erosion from Whipple Creek. The slope will be stabilized by building a gabion wall, which consists of a series of rock-filled wire baskets that are fastened together.

Drivers who use this section of NW 41st Avenue will need to use alternate routes, such as NW 179th Street, NW 51st Avenue and NW 169th Street. Temporary signs will guide drivers around the construction zone.
