Instructions: Please report to Clark County Communicable Disease Unit via fax or phone significant increases in school absenteeism resulting from gastrointestinal illness or suspected outbreaks of disease that may be associated with the school. (WAC 246-101-420)

When to report:

Please report each day throughout the school year when absences of students/staff population are $\geq 10\%$ with similar symptoms of diarrhea and/or vomiting **OR** 2 or more children from the same classroom are absent with diarrhea and/or vomiting within a 24 hour period.
