



Influenza-like Illness Report Form

Instructions: Please use this worksheet to report to Clark County Communicable Disease Unit a significant increase ($\geq 10\%$ population) in school absenteeism among staff/students resulting from influenza-like illness or clusters of particularly severe respiratory infections (WAC 246-110-020).

Influenza most commonly occurs between October and May, but outbreaks and sporadic cases can occur during any time of the year.
