The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has received the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' letter dated September 4, 2014, re-verifying coverage under Nationwide Permit (NWP) 43 for the above project. The NWP was re-verified to authorize a permit modification to correct a mitigation calculation error in the May 8, 2014 bank use plan.

Ecology has determined that the project meets the requirements for Washington State 401 Water Quality Certification under NWP 43. Therefore, an Individual 401 certification will not be required for this project and you may proceed as directed by the Corps.

Any changes to your project that would impact water quality should be submitted in writing to Ecology before work begins for additional review.
