<i>Sepsis Case Review</i>	<i>Dave and Debby</i>	<p>Sepsis data reviewed. (see data). Care facilities would like to have early recognition and response from providers for patients can be treated in facility rather than transfer to acute care. Better for patient. Issues:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Lack of education for front line staff on recognizing early signs of sepsis and steps to take 2. Difficulty with provider offices and care facilities getting labs back or calls back regarding labs and pt conditions 3. Should there be a standardized protocol that all care facilities could use to recognize and act on sepsis? 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
