The **hOur IMPACT** Time Bank, sponsored by the Human Services Council and Clark County, gives you easy access to the talents, time and skills of Clark County residents one hour at a time. **hOur IMPACT** is a time bank program where individuals exchange assets, resources and expertise with time as the sole currency. For every hour deposited in **hOur IMPACT**, members are able to withdraw an hour of service for their needs. **hOur IMPACT** provides a mechanism for people to come together within their community and a means for local interest groups/businesses to share skills and talents in a mutually beneficial way.

How does it work? **hOur IMPACT** has a website (www.hourimpact.org) where individuals and non-profit organizations can post service offerings that they would like to perform for other members and search for services they would like to receive.

Can a business or organization join? Yes. A business, organization (like a Neighborhood Association), or agency can create an account which members can use to give and receive services for the organization.
