A message from Clark County Public Works about an upcoming project in your area

NE 58TH STREET SIDEWALK

From Northeast 59th Avenue east to Northeast Andresen Road

PROJECT

CivilWorks NW, a Vancouver-based contractor working for Clark County Public Works, will build about 3,100 feet of sidewalk and fill in sidewalk gaps on both sides of the street.

Construction will be on the south side of Northeast 58th Street between Northeast 59th Avenue and Northeast 66th Avenue. It will cross to the north side at Northeast 66th Avenue and continue on the north side to Northeast Andresen Road.

WHEN WILL THE WORK BE DONE?

Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-May, and be completed in mid-summer 2016.

HOW WILL CONSTRUCTION AFFECT ME?

CivilWorks NW typically will work during daylight hours on weekdays, although the contractor could work some evenings and weekends. Residents living near the road work may experience some dust, vibration and noise, including backup alarms on construction vehicles.

Construction may require closing a lane on Northeast 58th Street because the contractor will need to stage equipment and supplies directly in the street.

Drivers could experience some short delays. Flaggers will direct vehicles through or around the work zone. Please follow the direction of flaggers at all times.

BUDGET

Clark County awarded a \$513,300 contract to CivilWorks NW to build this project, with construction dollars coming from the County Road Fund.
