

Addendum to SEPA Determination of Non-Significance

Purpose of Addendum:


In December 2015, trees toppled into Salmon Creek directly adjacent to Salmon Creek Street. This exposed a safety hazard related to the steep creek bank and the lack of barrier adjacent to the street. As a result, the initial project and SEPA DNS discussed shifting Salmon Creek Street, north, away from Salmon Creek. A comment period commenced on March 10, 2016 and ended on March 25, 2016. No comments affecting the SEPA DNS threshold were received.

That initial plan, while still viable does not address the overriding need to restore the stability of the eroding Salmon Creek bank. The purpose of this addendum is to address additional construction elements that were not envisioned at the time of the original SEPA determination. In addition to potentially shifting Salmon Creek Street, work will also repair the eroded Salmon Creek bank by adding approximately 200 feet of gabion baskets placed on a rip rap toe for additional structural stability. 6-8 pieces of large woody debris will be incorporated into the upstream portion of the project. Grading and planting native vegetation is also necessary on the south bank of Salmon Creek. The additional work will not change the analysis and SEPA Determination completed in March 2016.

Clark County Public Works is hereby issuing a SEPA Addendum pursuant to WAC 197-11-600.
