



The Clark County Urban Tree Canopy Restoration Project is a project with Friends of Trees to plant street trees in public rights-of-way and on public lands in the project area. Phase 1 of the pilot project will identify interested residential property owners in the North Salmon Creek, Felida, and West Hazel Dell neighborhood associations.

The project area is approximately 9.78 square miles (6,258 acres). The project will plant up to 500 large canopy trees over the course of the three years. Assuming the mature tree canopy coverage is 1,256 square feet a tree, this project will generate 14.42 acres of new tree canopy.
