


Dear resident,



Your vegetation along the county roadway needs to be pruned for the following reason(s):

- So that our maintenance vehicles can get next to the curb.
- Due to a traffic visibility problem.
- Due to a sidewalk/pedestrian obstruction.
- Due to impending street/roadway improvements.

Low-hanging vegetation can damage street sweepers and other county equipment. Homeowners are responsible for pruning and maintaining their vegetation, including debris disposal.

All low-hanging material needs to be trimmed to provide 14 feet of vertical clearance from the top of the curb and 8 feet of clearance from the full width of the sidewalk. Please see the other side of this hanger for a sketch illustrating these requirements.

If you have not completed this pruning or notified us by _____, a county road crew will cut back the vegetation. This work will be done at no cost, but it will not be done to a landscape quality desired by many residents.
