Advisory board needs commercial, industrial development expertise

Vancouver, WA – The Acting County Manager is seeking an applicant to serve on the Development and Engineering Advisory Board (DEAB). The new position is one associated with commercial or industrial development. The term would start immediately and continue for three years.

The advisory board reviews policy and county code changes and works on process improvements and fees with Community Development and Public Works.

The panel consists of ten members: three private-sector planners or engineers; one construction contractor; one public-sector planner or engineer; one land developer; one Building Industry Association representative; one associated with commercial or industrial development; and, two other professionals associated with development.

DEAB typically meets 2:30-4:30 p.m. on the first Thursday of the month at the Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin St.
