PUBLIC HEARING: DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT – WHIPPLE CREEK VILLAGE

To consider a development agreement for a proposed mixed senior housing and standard attached project at the northeast corner of NE 15th Avenue and NE 173rd Street. The proposal entails submitting a land use application for a zone change and subdivision for a project consisting of a mixture of 100 units of senior housing and 41 multi-family units. *Continued to from July 12, 2016*

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ACTION: Moved by Olson to **APPROVE** the development agreement that states the developer agrees to pay traffic impact fees for the project at the rate in effect when each building or site plan is approved, provided, the Board authorizes the developer to pay the rate of \$306 per trip for the first 41 units generated by the development. Further discussion ensued. Boldt seconded the motion. Chair Boldt and Councilors Olson voted aye. Councilors Stewart, Madore, and Mielke voted nay. Motion failed.

ACTION: Moved by Stewart to **APPROVE** development agreement for Whipple Creek Village under its original form. Boldt seconded the motion. Further discussion ensued. Chair Boldt and Councilors Stewart, Olson, Madore, and Mielke voted aye. Motion carried.

Board adjourned for a ten minute break.

Further discussion ensued. Councilor Madore and Mielke voted aye. Chair Marc Boldt, Councilors Stewart and Olson voted nay. Motion failed.

ACTION: Moved by Olson to **APPROVE** Resolution 2016-07-04. Stewart seconded the motion. Further discussion ensued. Chair Marc Boldt, Councilors Stewart and Olson voted aye. Councilor Madore and Mielke voted nay. Motion carried.
