Chris Cook, Deputy Prosecuting's Attorney, joined the discussion. Madore modified his motion to delete item O, section 1 entirely and renumber two, three, and four to be properly ordered. Barnes stated his concerns with the motions. Further discussion ensued. Mielke seconded the motion. Commissioners Mielke and Madore voted aye. Barnes voted nay. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING: SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM LIMITED AMENDMENT

To consider approval of a proposal that requests limited amendments to the Clark County Shoreline Master (SMP). The limited amendments would add Carty Lake to the list of shorelines subject to the SMP required by the law (WAC 173-20 & 90.58), it was erroneously omitted from the list during the County's 2012 update. The limited amendments will also allow dredging and disposal as part of ecological restoration and enhancement projects. The last amendments would allow non-water oriented commercial uses that are physically separated from the shoreline by another property or public right of way.
