

RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS, Clark County enacted its current fee waiver program with the passage of Resolution 2013-06-06; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the program is to stimulate private sector, job-producing economic development; and

WHEREAS, Section 8 of the Resolution contains provisions for its eventual review and repeal; and

WHEREAS, development applications can take months to assemble and prepare; and

WHEREAS, a sudden repeal of the fee waiver could alter the economic analysis of projects started but not yet approved; and

WHEREAS, a sudden repeal would create uncertainty about the risks and economics of initiating new development projects; and

WHEREAS, Clark County wishes to provide a stable, predictable economic environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board of County Councilors that to provide a predictable environment for job-creating economic development, the county will give a 360-day notice before ending the current fee waiver program.
