You have asked if the Coast guard has fulfilled the air draft requirements as requested of 125' and the answer is no. While the proposed air draft has been increased from 95' to 116' it is still not the 125' of the original requirement. It is my continued fear that simply convenience and not future needs are being looked at. The proposed bridge will become the cork in the bottle for anything moving upstream in the future and I currently have a vessel in my yard with a 135' mast.
