The Clark County Adopt-A-Road Program is designed to encourage volunteer involvement and community service in the control and reduction of litter and the enhancement of environmental quality along roadways. You can make a difference!

## Basic guidelines:

- Schedule cleanups at least 3 times a year
- 2 year commitment
- Wear safety vests and comply with all safety rules
- Adopted sections are 2 miles in length or less
- We provide cleanup kits



## Who can participate?

- Groups, businesses, individuals, schools, scouts, and many more!
- Must be 13 years of age
- Recognition sign will be installed after 1st cleanup

## Which sections of road are available?



- County has pre-approved several sections of road
- Other sections may be available once they have undergone a safety evaluation
