

## HYDROGEN PEROXIDE

**DISINFECTANT:** Spray on counters and other surfaces, then spray same area with white vinegar. Wipe clean with micro-fiber cloth.

**STAIN REMOVAL:** Spray on spot. Let dry. Increase effect by drying in the sun.

**BLEACH:** Add ½ cup to washer load in the rinse cycle.

**FIRST AID:** Spray on wounds. The bubbling action helps clean.

## SAFER SCRUB

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE!

**OVEN CLEANER:** Apply to inside of oven, scrub with sponge.

**GENERAL PURPOSE CLEANER:** Use to scrub showers/tubs, sinks.

**RECIPE:**

1 part baking soda    3 parts water    Dash Castile soap

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

Shake well. Apply and scrub with sponge. Rinse.

## WOOD POLISH

**RECIPE:**

Mix in spray bottle:

¼ cup white vinegar

1 teaspoon vanilla extract (optional)

a few drops essential oil (optional)

Add enough vegetable or olive oil to fill.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

Shake well. Apply and polish with soft cloth.

## BAKING SODA

Absorbs odors. Mild abrasive.

**SCOURING POWDER:** Sprinkle and wipe on sinks, tubs, etc. A drop or two of liquid soap will boost cleaning.

**DEODORIZER:** Place a partially filled saucer in refrigerator. Cycle out every 2 months, using old baking soda to clean drains. Sprinkle liberally on carpet, let stand for 1 hour or overnight, then vacuum.

## WHITE VINEGAR


**DISINFECTANT:** Use with Hydrogen Peroxide.

**RINSING AGENT:** Add to rinse cycle in dishwasher to eliminate spots. Add to rinse cycle in laundry to remove traces of soap.

**DEODORIZER:** Spray and wipe interior of refrigerator, microwave.

**MULTI-PURPOSE CLEANER:** Use in combination with salt to remove stubborn grease.

## GLASS CLEANER RECIPE

Mix in spray bottle:

¼ cup white vinegar

1/8 teaspoon liquid soap

Few drops of essential oil (optional)

Add enough hot water to fill.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

Use as you would any glass cleaner.
