


Clark County Public Health *organization chart*

Parent-Child Health and Nurse Family Partnership

Nurse home visits that support healthy families, growth & development of infants & children

WIC

Nutrition education, food supplements & health-related referral

Oral Health

Educating & promoting positive oral health activities, technical assistance to health care providers; assessing oral health status of community

Infectious Disease

Disease & outbreak investigation & surveillance, health education & prevention counseling for notifiable conditions

Reproductive Health

Family planning, counseling, education, clinical services, STD screening, diagnosis and treatment

Tuberculosis

Screening, diagnosis & treatment of persons with active TB or latent TB infection

Health Care Access

Education & training services to increase health care access

Immunizations

Distributes, oversees & monitors free vaccines for children to health care providers. Administers vaccinations.

HIV/AIDS Prevention

Education & outreach services to high risk individuals; HIV counseling, testing & syringe exchange

HIV Case Management

Coordination & assistance with medical care, housing, mental health & substance abuse services

Assessment

Measurement of community health indicators and reporting to community; analysis of trends & tracking benchmarked health indicators providing basis for public health initiatives;

Evaluation

Systematic evaluation of program effectiveness leading to quality improvement

Outreach

Proactive, ongoing communication with providers and community to promote public health practices and messages

Tobacco

Works through community partners to prevent initiation and support cessation of use of tobacco products

Safe Food/Water/Air & Healthy Community Growth Jonnie Hyde 397-8122

Water

Assures adequate quantity & quality of drinking water

Solid/Hazardous Waste

Assures solid and hazardous wastes are properly disposed

Liquid Waste

Protects groundwater & prevents illness by oversight of treatment of domestic sewage.

Provides foodhandler education & certification & food service inspections
