Moderate Means accepts people whose income is 200-400% of the federal poverty guidelines. This program handles only consumer, family, and housing issues. Clients may pay a reduced fee, and retainer amounts are set by the attorney.

If you are 55 or older, you can schedule a free half-hour meeting with an attorney on Wednesdays from 1-3 p.m. at 1009 E. McLoughlin Blvd. Call 360-487-7050 for an appointment. They also provide monthly classes on elder law issues.

**CLARK COUNTY VOLUNTEER
LAWYERS PROGRAM**

CCVLP is located at: 1409 Franklin Street, Suite 101, Vancouver WA 98660. This nonprofit provides free legal help to Clark County residents with income up to 200% of poverty guidelines in civil cases in the Clark County courts.

Call CLEAR at 1-888-201-1014 (see next column) for the advice clinic. If referred, you will be called within one week:

Advice clinic: Eligible clients meet with an attorney for 30 minutes to discuss legal issues, receive advice, and ask questions.

In limited cases an attorney will volunteer to represent you. Waiting periods apply.

They also run the **Housing Justice Project** for low-income tenants at risk of eviction or who have been served with an eviction notice. Call 360-334-4007 for possible assistance.

FIRSTENBURG COMMUNITY CENTER

If you are 65 or older, you can schedule a free half-hour meeting with an attorney on the first Monday of the month from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. to discuss elder law topics such as wills or estate planning. Call 360-487-7001 to schedule an appointment.
