

Building Information, Tips, and Services

Clark County Building Safety developed two communication tools intended to foster consistency among inspectors and help our customers prepare for inspections.

In 2018, Building Safety began an extra effort to ensure inspectors consistently make the same calls when passing inspections or requiring corrections. One morning each week, all inspectors meet at a site to discuss inspection consistency for a particular stage of construction. These inspection consistency meetings began with site preparation and will progress through the final stages of home construction. These sessions are valuable in the on-boarding period for new inspectors and for the group to discuss each other's perspectives.

To promote inspection readiness and increase the frequency of passing inspections on our first visit,

Building Safety will distribute International Code Council (ICC) Code Check guides to homebuilders and subcontractors. ICC Code Check guides are an excellent tool that builders and contractors can use to prepare their projects for successful inspections and avoid re-inspections.
