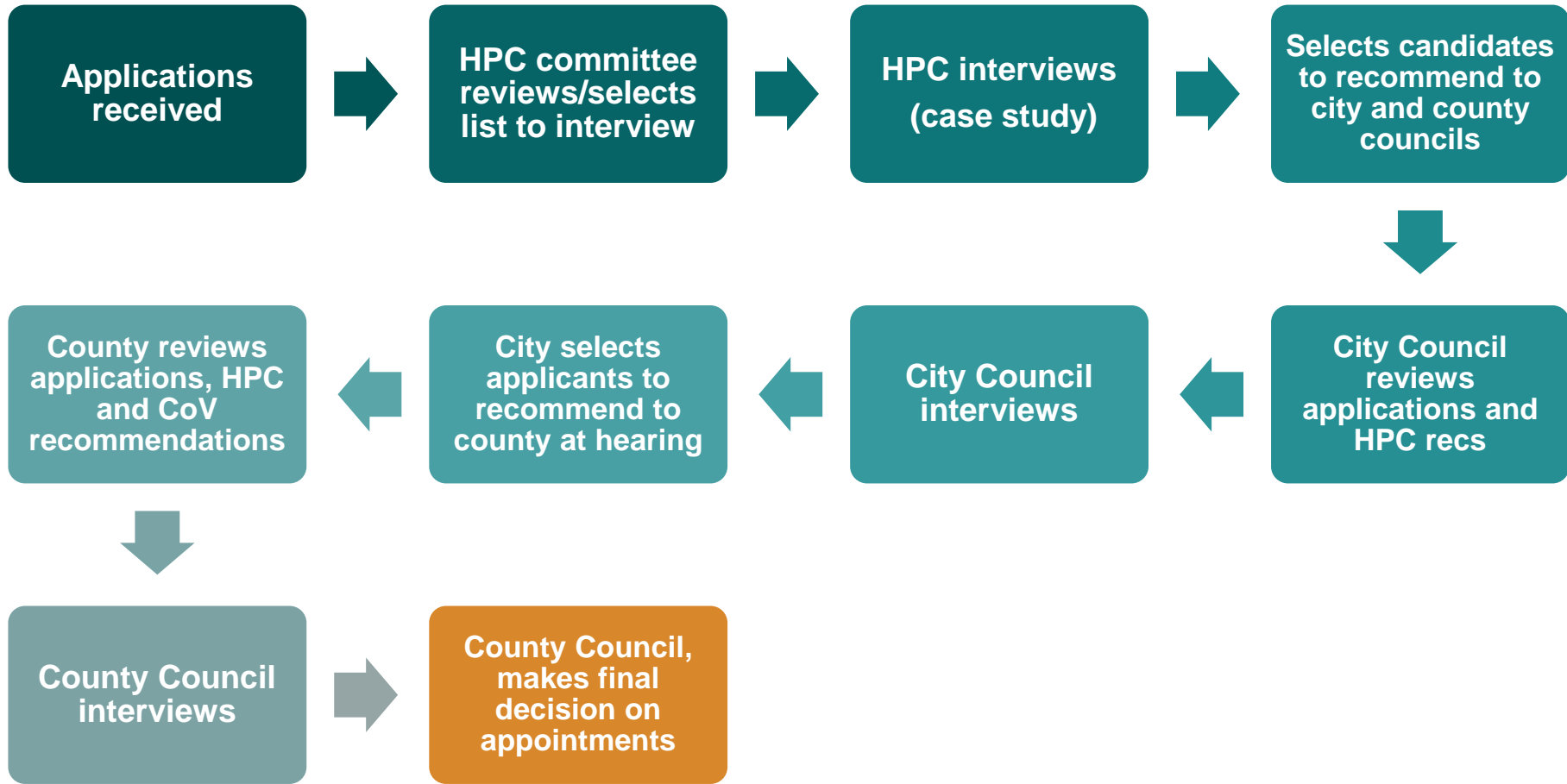

Current HPC appointment process



Historic Preservation Commission per 40.250.030

- Minimum of five members (currently seven)
- Demonstrated special interest, experience or knowledge in history, historic preservation, architecture or related disciplines
- Must always include at least two professionals who have experience identifying, evaluating, and protecting historic and cultural resources and are selected from among the disciplines of:
 - History
 - Public history
 - Architecture
 - Architectural history
 - Historic preservation
 - Planning
 - Cultural anthropology
 - Archaeology
 - Cultural geography
 - American studies
 - Historic rehabilitation



Summary of Title 40.250.030 Updates

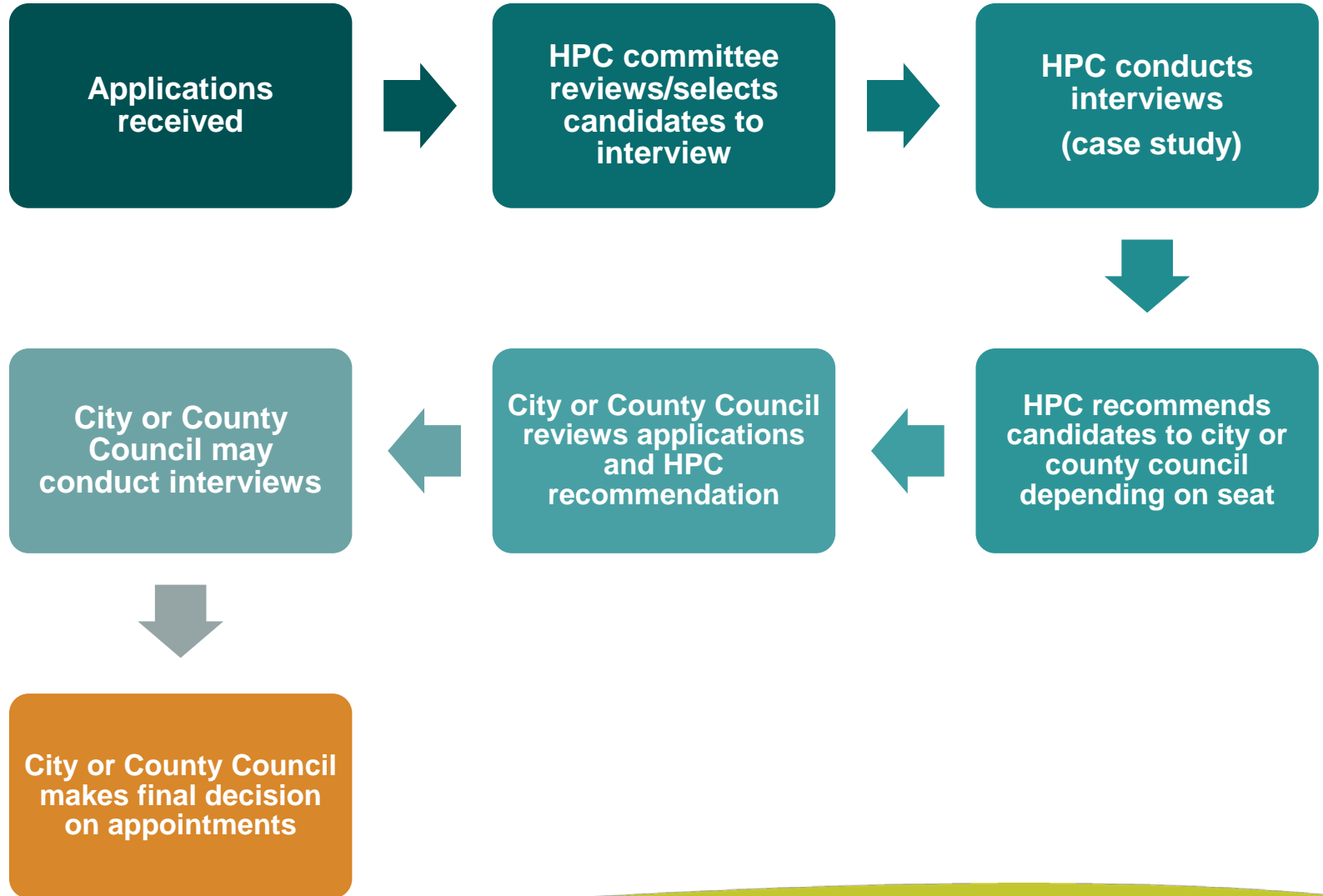
Amendments:

- Increase minimum number of HPC members from five to seven
- City of Vancouver to appoint two members and the county to appoint five members
- Update the “Appeals” process on HPC’s decisions to state the process for properties in cities/town is indicated in city/town code or defaults to county process (Superior Court)

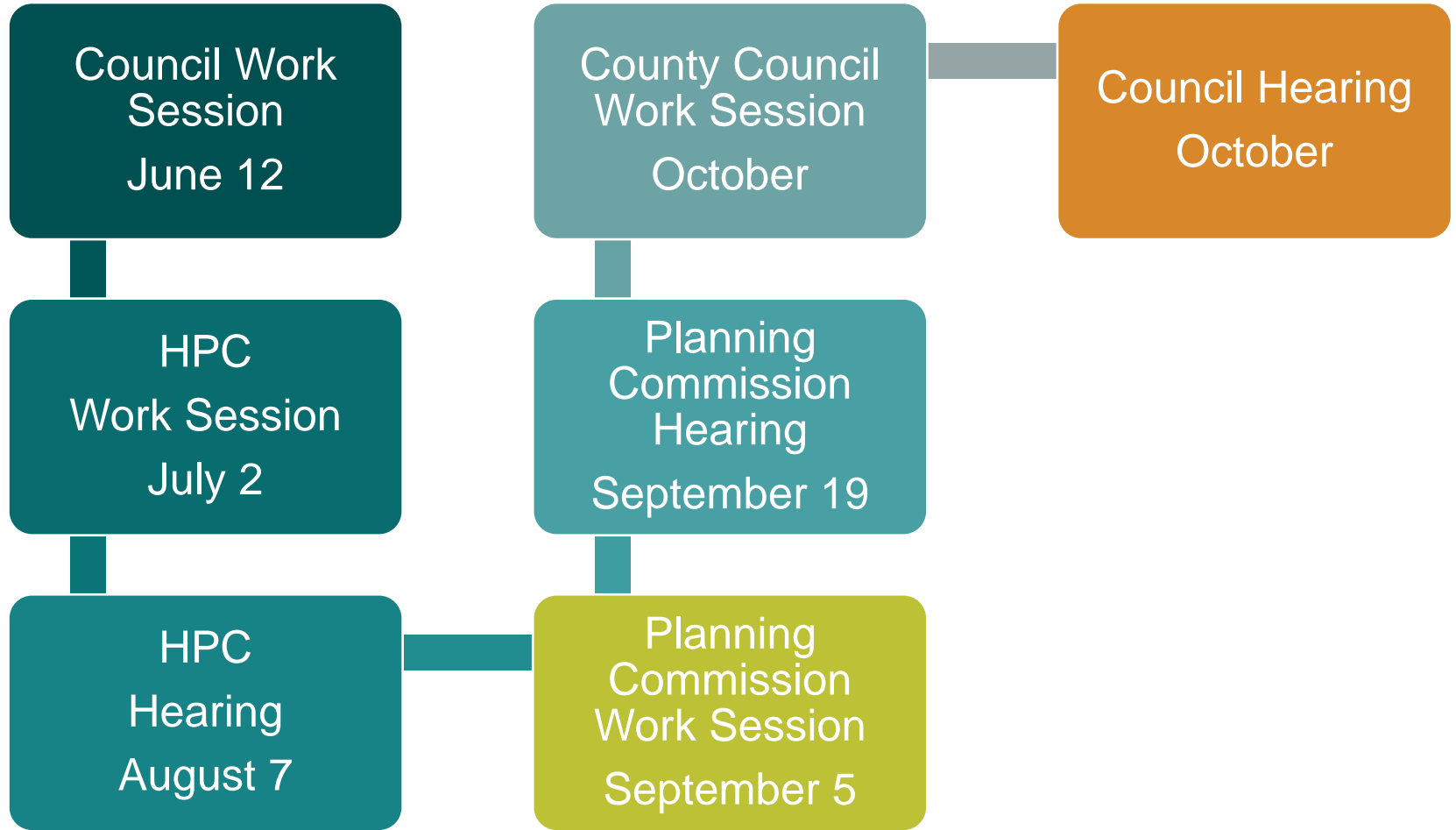
