## Learn about Normal Aging

Aging reflects changes that occur over the course of life. Some changes are normal and expected as we age, and others, such as memory loss and confusion, are not. Shanti Potts, an instructor at Clark College, the Area of Agency on Aging and Disabilities of Southwest Washington and the Developmental Disabilities Administration, will speak about factors that contribute to pseudo-dementia and its early signs and symptoms.

Potts has more than 25 years of experience working with and advocating for seniors and those with disabilities. She has worked with unpaid family caregivers and professional care providers, and spent a dozen years in memory care and assisted living management.



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
