FISCAL IMPACT ATTACHMENT

Part I: Narrative Explanation

I.A - Explanation of what the request does that has fiscal impact and the assumptions for developing revenue and costing information.

The NE 119th Street at NE 50th Avenue Intersection project will widen, signalize, and add turn lanes at the intersection of NE 119th Street and NE 50th Avenue. The widening will continue for several hundred feet on all four legs of the intersection and then taper back to the existing roadways. The steep hill on NE 119th east of NE 50th Avenue will be shaved down. Stormwater treatment will be addressed.

The total cost for construction is estimated at \$3,774,000.

This project is programmed in the 2013-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and 2013 Annual Construction Program (Item 3). The revenues and expenses for this project are currently included in the 2013/2014 budget.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until 1:50 P.M. on Tuesday, April 2, 2013, by the Clark County Board of County Commissioners through the General Services Purchasing Department, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660, for the NE 119th St @ NE 50th Avenue, CRP No. 313622; and other work; then publicly opened and read aloud at the Commissioners' Hearing Room, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Vancouver, Washington 98660, at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, April 2, 2013, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

Description of work: This project will widen the intersection of NE 119th Street @ NE 50th Avenue to the ultimate width, with sidewalks, signalized the intersection and left turn lanes. There will be dedicated right turn lanes on NE 119th Street onto south bound NE 50th Avenue and from NE 50th Avenue to east bound NE 119th Street. It also entails shaving down the hill on NE 119th Street, which is east of 50th Avenue and installing retaining walls.

Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Clark County Road Fund.

The right is reserved by the Clark County Board of County Commissioners to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a proposal of the lowest responsible bidder, reject any or all bids, republish the call for bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the Contracting Agency is served.


