	BACKGROUND: The NPDES Municipal Stormwater Permit Annual Report describes the county's permit compliance actions during 2012 to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology). The 2013 Clark County Stormwater Management Plan (Plan) provides a detailed description of Clark County programs that manage stormwater and stormwater-related activities to protect surface water and ground water; it also meets National Pollutant Discharge Elimination Systems (NPDES) municipal stormwater permit requirements. The 2013 Plan is a comprehensive county program description that includes all areas of stormwater management, not just those specific to NPDES permit requirements. The Annual Report and Plan were prepared by the Clean Water Program using information from departments and programs responsible for implementing stormwater management. All NPDES permit-related reports to Ecology require certification by a principal executive officer, a ranking elected official, or a duly authorized representative before submittal.  COMMUNITY OUTREACH: The county holds bimonthly Clean Water Commission meetings that are advertised and open to the public. The current Plan is available on the Web for public comment.  BUDGET AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS: Submitting the Annual Report, Plan and its attachments, as well as the Flow Control Restoration Program summary by March 31, 2012 is an NPDES permit requirement.
