Dear Property Owner:
Clark County Community Planning is gathering information from some property owners to learn how to better support and encourage you in the conservation and management of your resource land. The goal is to maintain the current zoning but provide more economic flexibility for your property, should you want it.
The Board of County Commissioners is interested to know which of the limited options individual property owners would prefer regarding the size of their parcel or parcels. To the extent possible, the board wants to consider an owner's preference, not simply set a parcel size in a particular zone.
To be clear, the board <i>cannot</i> guarantee a particular result. It will, however, attempt to incorporate natural, legal and existing development conditions with the interests of owners when possible.
